Common Summer Camp Fee Questions

Making a Reservation:

To reserve space at camp, make a deposit and submit a reservation form. Family Camp does not need a deposit, however payment in full is due May 15.

Payment Schedule:

Camp fee payments occur in 3 steps:

1. Initial Non Refundable Unit deposit of \$250
2. To qualify for the Early Bird discount, pay the balance by May 15. Otherwise, the balance must be paid in full two weeks prior to camp.

Making Changes to a Reservation:

Make changes to your reservation **in writing**. Include the pack number, reservation number, changes requested, name of person requesting the change and phone number. It is necessary to have changes in writing to ensure that your reservation is correct.

Refund Policy:

Planning and purchasing for camp happened long before camp begins and is based on your reservation of space at camp. Consequently, refunds are made as follows:

1. Cancellations of or before May 15: all fees paid, less the \$250 deposit are transferrable.
2. Between May 15 and May 31, all fees paid, less the \$250 deposit, and the \$50 per scout deposit are transferable.
3. After May 31, no refunds are made unless the one of the following is met:
 - Family moves out of Council.
 - There is a death or serious illness in immediate family.
 - The individual becomes ill and is unable to attend camp.
4. No refunds will be granted within two weeks of camp.
5. Refund Request received after camp, or for "no shows" will NOT be honored.

If a refund is given, it will be 50% fees paid. Refund checks are mailed in early November and will be made to the Unit Leader.

Requesting a Refund:

UP to two weeks prior to camp a unit may submit the refund request form to the council office. No refunds will be granted within two weeks of camp. If granted refunds will be issued in November.

Partnership for Scouting Rebate:

The Great Southwest Council units that become Partnership for Scouting units in 2019 qualify for a 10% rebate on summer camp fees. Rebate checks will be presented at the Scoutmaster Dinner on Thursday evening. For more information about Partnership for Scouting, visit www.gswcbsa.org/partnership.
