Please read the following:

1. As a Boy Scout I agree to obey the Scout Oath and Law.

The Scout Law

A Scout is trustworthy, loyal, helpful, friendly, courteous, kind, obedient, cheerful, thrifty, brave, clean, and reverent.

The Scout Oath

On my honor, I will do my best, to do my duty to God and my country, to obey the Scout Law, to help other people at all times, and to keep myself physically strong, mentally awake, and morally straight.

2. I will follow all the rules of the Boy Scouts of America and the Great Southwest Council. I will follow all Camp Rules, which are explained to me at staff training sessions.
3. I will listen to all the adult Staff and follow their instructions. If I don't feel comfortable following their instructions, I will inform them I am uncomfortable and go talk to another adult about the situation.
4. At Brownsea, I will participate in all activities unless a documented medical condition restricts my activities.
5. If I have any problems I will go to an Adult Staff Member.
6. I will not humiliate my fellow Scouts or staff members in any way.
7. I will not destroy or break any camp or personal property.
8. I will show respect to all campers, as well as my fellow Staff members. I will in turn receive respect.
9. As a staff member of the Brownsea-22 program I realize that I have been given a great opportunity, but with that, a great responsibility. I will at all times act in an appropriate manner. This includes, but is not limited to: treating all campers and staff members with respect, and following the directions of the Adult Staff Member.
10. Matters which I feel are sensitive I will discuss only with the adult staff to respect the privacy and dignity of the person(s) involved.
11. Upon becoming a staff member I will read and sign a list of duties and responsibilities that I will do as a member of Brownsea Staff.
